

DIY RAINBOW ART

Let me show you how to make some gorgeous rainbow canvas art for your home. You'll be so surprised by how easy and effective this project is. Anyone can try it! Team your rainbow art with some other simple geometric designs, and you'll have a stand out gallery wall in your home.



Supplies: You'll need some DAS Exhibition Canvases, tubes of Reeves Acrylic Paints, a tube of Reeves Coarse Texture Gel, a set of Reeves Acrylic Short Handle Brushes and a paint tray. You may also want to use a ruler and protractor as guides.

step one:

Mix up the colours for your background - I added white to all of mine to create a nice light colour palette. Then paint a coat all over each canvas, including the sides. Dry overnight.



step two:

Mix up the paints for your rainbows. I chose darker colours than the backgrounds, and mixed each with some Coarse Texture Gel to create a textured effect. Now paint on your designs. Start with some rainbows, using a protractor to help with the first arc. Then try combinations of lines, arcs, circles and blocks of colour.



step three:

Display in your home on their own, in groups, or as a beautiful statement gallery wall.
