

3 Fun ways to Gift Wrap!

INSPIRATION STATION

Christmas is a great time to get creative and hands-on with your gift wrapping. Try these ideas this year, and you will have such fun and appealing gifts sitting under your tree!

DIY Holly:

Cut coloured card into the shape of holly leaves. Then use a hot glue gun to stick the leaves to your gift, with pom poms as the berries in the centre.

Festive bunting:

Cut little triangles out of coloured card. Tape some twine across your present, then use pegs to attach the triangles.

TIP: These are fun projects to do with the kids! Get some kid scissors to suit their ability, and they can help with cutting shapes, painting and gluing on the embellishments.

Painted Paper:

Take large sheets of paper, and paint triangle trees with rectangle stumps, or stars. Once the paint has dried, use a pen to draw the shapes over the top, which make them pop! Use this as your wrapping paper.
