

- Do not use umbrella in windy or rainy conditions
- This product is not designed as a permanent structure.
- To prolong the life of your umbrella, we recommend you use an umbrella cover
- Store inside when not in use.
- Keep hands clear of moving parts.
- 4 x 15kg pavers required to hold base in place. (not included)




Tips before you start

1. Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your product.
2. For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly, that you identify all the parts required for that step.
3. For larger items, please ensure that you have sufficient space and people (as indicated on page 1) to assemble your product safely.
4. We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
5. For the protection of your product, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
6. During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product. Do not use power tools.
7. Always place the product on a flat, steady and stable surface.
8. This product is intended household use only as it is a non-industrial product.
9. Please use caution and care when lifting the product to avoid personal injury and/or product damage.

Care and maintenance

- When left exposed to the elements for a period of time, steel may rust and fabric may fade.
- To prolong the life of your product, clean and dry frame regularly.
- Use car polish or similar product for extra protection of metal components. Use spray lubricant or similar on nuts and bolts.
- We recommend storing product, under cover, out of direct sunlight and using product, covers when not in use and for protection during the winter months.
