## SWAN TABLE LAMP

### Instructions

Please read these instructions and warnings carefully before operating to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

Please also retain these instructions for future use.

#### Warnings:

- This is a Class III lamp fitting supplied via a Class II a.c Adaptor and does not require an earth connection.
- Use only in conjunction with the a.c. Adaptor supplied with the fitting.
- Always use the correct type and wattage of bulb.
- When installing a bulb, never handle the glass surface directly, always use a clean / dry / lint free cloth to avoid surface contamination. Failure to do so can result in premature bulb failure and possible bulb rupture.
- When changing a bulb, always switch off the light at the wall socket and allow the bulb to cool down before handling.
- Dispose of old bulbs carefully.
- Do not switch on the light until the installation is complete.
- Ensure the bulb sleeve guard (clear cover) is fitted over the bulb during use, this is provided to prevent inadvertent contact of the bulb which can get very hot in use.
- Turn off the appliance when not in use.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the luminaire.
- The fitting is intended for indoor use only.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- For operation only with a.c. supplied independent electronic controlgear for LED modules in accordance with AS/NZS IEC 61347.2.13.

**CAUTION:** The light bulb operates at a high temperature, avoid direct contact and ensure the bulb sleeve guard (clear cover) is fitted.

**CAUTION:** Never exceed the bulb wattage stated.

## Bulb Installation and operation:

1. The bulb is installed through an opening in the underside of the fitting. Carefully turn the unit over or raise the unit from the support surface to access the lampholder.
2. Install the recommended bulb, note the bulb surface must not be contacted directly as this can cause surface contamination to create localised hot spots and premature bulb failure / rupture. Use a clean / dry / lint free cloth.
3. Fit the bulb sleeve guard (clear cover) over the bulb and push onto the lampholder surround to secure in place.
4. Place the lamp fitting on a stable / dry and level support surface.
5. Insert the supply cord plug into a suitable mains outlet and use the in-line cord switch to operate.
