## Himalayan Salt Table Lamp

### Instructions

Please read these instructions and warnings carefully before operating to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

Please also retain these instructions for future use.

#### Warnings:

- This is a Class II product and does not require an earth connection.
- Always use the correct type and wattage of bulb.
- When changing a bulb, always switch off the light at the wall socket and allow the bulb to cool down before handling.
- Dispose of old bulbs carefully.
- Do not switch on the light until the installation is complete.
- Do not cover the lamp or bulb during use as this could be a potential safety hazard.
- Turn off the appliance when not in use.
- The luminaire is not intended for use by children unless suitable adult supervision is provided.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the luminaire.
- The fitting is intended for indoor use only.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Keep away from water. Water can compromise the electrical safety and will dissolve / damage the salt body.
- Leave the lamp on continuously or for at least 30 minutes per day to prevent moisture build up.
- When not switched on for an extended period, your salt lamp will absorb moisture from the air and may weep. To protect the lamp and the light bulb, simply wipe dry before switching on again.
- Do not place the salt lamp on top of electrical appliances.
- Dry dust to clean, do not use water or cleaning products.
- It is recommended to place your salt lamp on a protective mat or coaster to protect your furniture.

**CAUTION:** Ensure that the light bulb is not within the recommended 0.5m of any surface when operating as this could be a potential safety hazard.

**CAUTION:** Never exceed the bulb wattage stated.

#### Unpacking and operation:

- 1.Remove protective overwrap / packaging from the salt body and base, discard along with silica gel moisture absorber packet.
- 2.Remove protective plastic bag from the supply cord and discard.
- 3.If the salt crystal is damp, gently wipe it with a clean lint free towel.
- 4.Check that the electrical supply cord and plug is undamaged, never operate this lamp with damaged cord or plug.
- 5.Place the light fitting in the upright position on a flat and stable surface, near an electrical socket outlet.
- 6.Insert the supply plug into the electrical socket outlet and use the cordline switch to control the on / off state of the lamp.

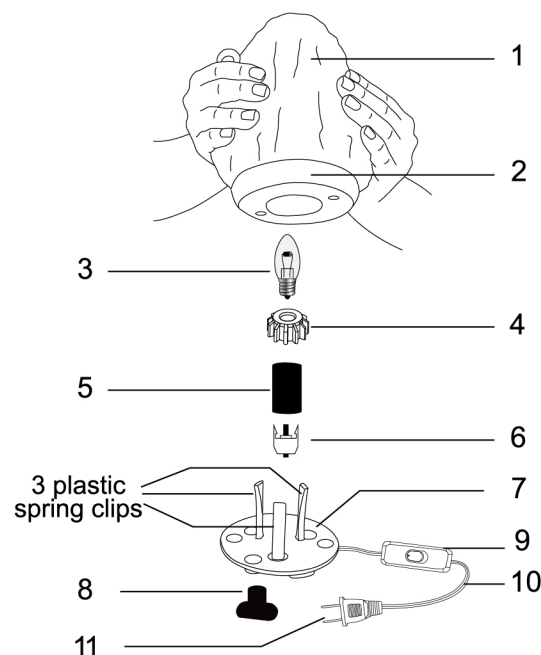
**Note 1:** If the lamp does not operate, check the electrical supply socket is working and switched on. If the lamp still does not operate, follow the instructions 1 – 3) below then check the bulb is securely tightened (loosening may have occurred in transit). If the lamp still does not operate, it is possible the bulb has been damaged in transit, please obtain a replacement from your local store.

#### How to change the bulb:

- 1.Disconnect the electrical plug and cord from the mains supply.
- 2.Lay the lamp fitting on its side on a flat stable surface.
- 3.Gently pull the black plastic base assembly away from the salt body / wooden base, place the salt body with wooden base and plastic base assembly upright side by side on the supporting surface.
- 4.Hold the lampholder body with one hand and using your other hand, hold and rotate the bulb in an anti-clock wise orientation until fully loosened, then remove from the lampholder.
- 5.Check to ensure the rubber gasket remains attached at the top of the lampholder (Product construction and component part names (Item 4) on the following page).
- 6.Take the replacement bulb from the packet (Note 2), insert the screw thread into the lampholder er and rotate it in the clock-wise orientation until fully inserted.
- 7.Press the 3 plastic spring clips of the black plastic base inwards towards the lampholder and insert the black plastic base assembly back into the salt body / wooden base aperture until the face of the black plastic base sits in contact with the wooden base.
- 8.Place the light fitting in the upright position on a flat and stable surface, near an electrical socket outlet.
- 9.Insert the supply plug into the electrical socket outlet and use the cordline switch to control the on / off state of the lamp.

**Note 2:**In order to maximize longevity of your light bulb, do not directly handle the glass. Use a small clean / dry and lint free cloth to prevent skin contact. Bulbs are sensitive to vibration and shock and can be damaged easily, please handle with care.
