HELLO NEON WALL LIGHT

Instructions

Please read these instructions and warnings carefully before operating to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

Please also retain these instructions for future use.

Warnings:

- This is a Class III lamp fitting supplied via a Class II a.c Adaptor and does not require an earth connection.
- Use only in conjunction with the a.c. adaptor supplied with the fitting.
- The light fitting incorporates an integrated LED lighting strip, the LED lighting cannot be replaced, do not attempt to remove.
- Do not switch on the light until the assembly is complete.
- Do not cover the lamp fitting during use as this could be a potential safety hazard.
- The luminaire is not intended for use by children unless suitable adult supervision is provided.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the luminaire.
- The fitting is intended for indoor use only.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by a suitably qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Only use the light fitting in conjunction with the AC power adaptor provided.
- Ensure the fitting has been securely fitted to the support wall.
- Only use the locating / mounting holes provided, do not attempt to make alternative fixings.
- Do not locate the fitting in a high heat or high humidity environment (ie above cooking appliances or in wet areas such as bathrooms).
- Ensure supply cables are not pulled taut and are located to avoid trip hazards.
- For operation only with a.c. supplied independent electronic control gear for LED modules in accordance with AS/NZS IEC 61347.2.13.

Assembly:

1. Remove protective plastic overwrap and packaging from the lamp assembly including adhesive backing tape from the rear of the main body.
2. Mount the fitting to a support wall using the screws and fixing hardware provided, utilising the locating lugs in the rear panel of the support (refer image over page Items A and B).
3. Connect the output lead of the a.c. power adaptor to the input socket of the light fitting (refer image over page Item C).
4. Insert the a.c. adaptor plug pins into a mains socket outlet (refer image over page Item D) and switch on.

Mounting and connection:
